12-18 Months

- Insure your engagement ring.

Nine Months

- \Box Start searching for decor inspiration.
- $\hfill\square$ Decide on a rehearsal dinner venue, menu and guest list.
- □ Try on bridal gowns.
- Design and order invitations.
- Book a florist.
- \square Research and select bridesmaid dresses.
- $\hfill\square$ Choose a caterer for your reception.
- $\hfill\square$ Taste samples and order a cake/desserts.
- Research honeymoon sites, and book your hotel/accommodations.
- □ Request all necessary days off work.

Six Months

- $\hfill\square$ Select attire for groom, groomsmen, flower girl and ring bearer.
- $\hfill\square$ Make appointments for hair and makeup.
- $\hfill\square$ Create a wedding website if you would like to have one.
- \Box Send out save-the-date cards.
- $\hfill\square$ Arrange a block of hotels for those coming from out-of-town.
- \Box Schedule a bridal portrait session.

Four Months

- \square Buy wedding bands and finalize wedding accessories.
- $\hfill\square$ Book a wedding night hotel and finalize honeymoon plans.
- $\hfill\square$ Arrange your transportation between venues for the wedding day.
- $\hfill\square$ Start working on vows if writing your own.
- \Box Create a song list for the band or DJ.

Two Months

- \Box Schedule a dress fitting.
- $\hfill\square$ Invite rehearsal dinner guests.
- $\hfill\square$ Plan the order of your ceremony with your officiant.
- □ Mail wedding invitations.
- Write and mail thank you notes for any bridal showers.
 - Buy thank you gifts for the bridal party and parents.

One Month

- Prepare a photo/video shoot checklist for the photographer. $\hfill\square$
- Recruit helpers to man guest book and distribute programs. \Box
 - Get your license for marriage (usually good for 60 days). \square
 - Check in with those who have not RSVP'd. 🗌
- Get haircuts, teeth whitening and any other cosmetic procedures. \square
 - Prepare welcome bags for guests staying at nearby hotels. \Box

One to Two Weeks

- Confirm wedding day details with all vendors. \Box
- Finalize your seating chart for the reception. \square
- Pack for the wedding night and honeymoon trip. \square
- Communicate to the wedding party about the day-of schedule. $\hfill\square$
 - Schedule a run through of hair and makeup. $\hfill\square$

The Last Few Days

- Get a manicure/pedicure and pamper yourself. $\hfill\square$
- Decorate the venue the day before if possible. \Box
- Give out wedding party gifts at the rehearsal dinner. $\hfill\square$
- Show up early for your rehearsal, and clarify any $\ \square$
 - questions with your officiant and wedding party.
 - Thank your parents and other loved ones. $\hfill\square$
- Pack all attire, and remind the wedding party when to arrive. \square
